INTRODUCTION

In Isaiah 55: 10 – 11 we read the following:

¹⁰For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returns not thither, but waters the earth, and makes it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:

¹¹So shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

To proclaim comes from a Latin Word called to “shout forth”. Related to confession or meaning agreement or the same as. Confession means we say the same with our mouths as God has already said in His Word. When Jesus said that we must pray, “As in heaven so on earth”, the original meaning is, “As it already is in heaven, so let it be on earth.” In other words, it is established. We make the words of our mouth agree with the Words of our God. We are taking ground and enforcing the Kingdom of Heaven on this earth by our confession of faith. In this way we line ourselves up with His authority. Jesus is the High Priest of our confession. He is the High Priest in respect to what we confess. This is why it is so important to guard our mouths. Proverbs 18: 20 – 21 says:

²⁰A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled.

²¹Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

So it is imperative that we understand that as we confess in faith the Word of God, Jesus our great and mighty High Priest is there to hasten His word and to perform it.

Psalm 138:2

²I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: **for thou hast magnified Thy word above all Thy Name.**

Derek Prince says the following about proclamation:

Proclamation is a word of spiritual warfare...a confession made aggressive. It is the activity of a herald proclaiming. A herald was given the authority and made a proclamation of the will or decision of the ruler in that particular place.

We have been given authority by our Great High Priest. We are here to proclaim the Word, which is His will in any given situation. It is to set a standard. This is more than teaching, this is drawing a line in the spirit.

Matthew 16:18 says

¹⁸And I say also unto thee, that thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. The Word of God is the final authority.

The revelation that Peter received by the Spirit of God is that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the Living God. He is the Rock of our salvation. His Word is also said to be a rock, as we see in the example of the man that built his house on the sand verses the man who built his house on the rock. Jesus said, so is such a man that does what I say.

Jesus also said to satan, when tempted in the wilderness that He should turn the rocks into bread, "man shall not live from bread alone, but from every word that proceeds from the mouth of God". We live by the Word of God. This is our food. To do His will is our meat. So to proclaim His Word is to make a proclamation not of what we think, how we see things or what we have to say. But rather, when we speak His Word we are speaking the Word of the Creator into the spiritual atmosphere, confronting the principalities and powers with the Word of God. When

Jesus said we are not living from bread alone, but from every word that comes from the mouth of God, He was referencing not just to physical bread, but spiritual bread. Remember that He said, I am the Bread of Life. But here He is saying we are to live from the spoken Word. Not just the LOGOS, but the RHEMA. We no longer live, but Christ lives in us. We live and move and have our being in Him. He speaks through us. So it is vital that we do not take the Word of God, and swing it around recklessly. When the Spirit of God speaks through us, we know it is like a two-edged sword, dividing between bone and marrow, and soul and spirit. It is a discerner of the intents of the heart and leaves all to stand naked before the Lord. But when we use scripture as arrows, which are the verses, it is as fiery darts into the enemy's camp of darkness.

John 1:5-9

⁵And the light shines in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

We have within our hands available the very Word of God, which worketh by faith. The very thing the enemy dreads is for us to realize the authority and dunamis power we have in Christ. He does not want us to know who we are in Christ or that Christ is mighty in us to do valiantly through us and create absolute havoc in his kingdom. Jesus has given us keys of authority and He has given us His Word that is exalted above His Name. This He has given us and we MUST use it.

We need to realize that the Bible is a supernatural book. The power is limitless.

Psalm 33:6

⁶By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

All things were created by the Word of God and the Spirit of God (the breath). We have both and they go together.

Jeremiah 23:29

²⁹Is not my word like as a fire? says the LORD; and like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces?
This rock in this context can be seen as strongholds.

God's Word does great and mighty things when we speak His Word by His Spirit and in faith.

2 Corinthians 3: 6

⁶Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the Spirit:
for the letter killeth, but the Spirit giveth life.

This means that the Bible with all its wonderful verses are just words without the Spirit and bring with it a knowledge of judgment, but the Spirit gives life. It has to be the Word and the Spirit together. It has to have the breath of God in it.

Romans 12: 1 – 2 says that we are to give our members as a living sacrifice unto the Lord and renew our minds and not be conformed to this world, so that we may know what is the good, acceptable and perfect will of God.

This whole world has been programmed through various mediums to think a certain way. The Bible says that as a man thinketh, so is he. Our minds have to be renewed in what we think about. If you have negative thought patterns, you have a responsibility to change these thought patterns by creating new ones. Think of this as creating new brain pathways. Your mind is triggered by a certain situation and automatically it goes down the normal negative pathway. You however have to form a new path way. Your brain will in the beginning still go the wrong way, but will gradually through repetition start the new path way. You have to be diligent in this regard.

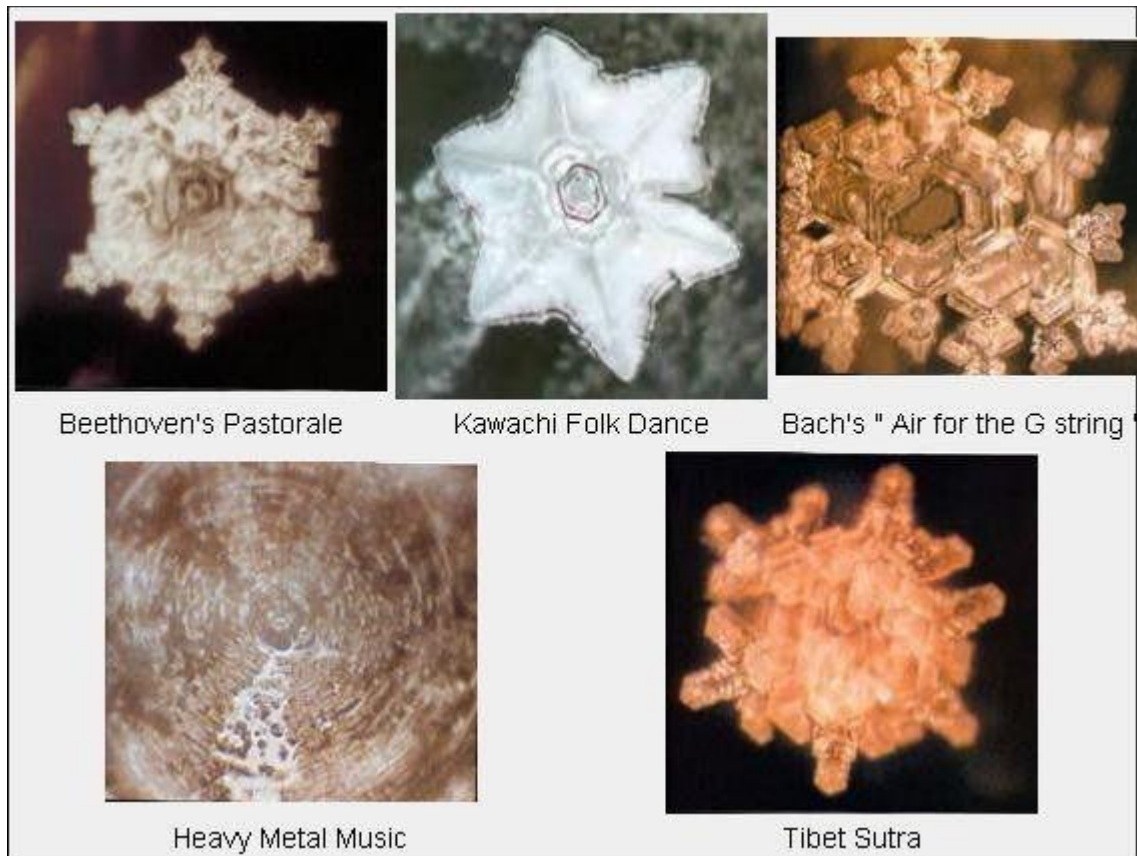
There are various reasons for disease, but toxic thoughts also influences our bodies and causes allergies, cancer, arthritis and many more illnesses. This is often the root problem and we often

are so overwhelmed by the fruit (the symptoms) that we seldom deal with the root issues. Be sure to do both.

Studies have been done on droplets of water to see how they react under the different vibrations of certain music. The difference between the affect rock music has on a droplet of water and the patterns it makes, versus the patterns made when classical music is played is huge. This is because sound has vibration. Why is this important? Because we are made of 70% water in our bodies. When Jesus said to the Samaritan woman, if you drink of me living waters will flow from your innermost being, the living waters is the Spirit of God literally changing the cells in our bodies. The truth of the Word of God said in faith changes our molecular structure. Not only that, but the David said in Psalm 119 that the entrance of God's Word gives light and understanding to the simple. This is not just light in the sense of being able to see clearer, but when Jesus said He is the light of this world and that we too are the light of the world, this simply means that in the spiritual, we really do shine as light. The enemy has hijacked this truth by calling it an "aura" and they say that people have a certain color hue or aura around them that they can see. We shine as the children of Light because of the Word of God in us, but also we ourselves have the living water of the Word of God in us, to give drink to the thirsty. There is always a physical manifestation of the spiritual. Moses' face shone when He came down from the mountain and He had to use a veil to cover his face. The Word says that the Jews are still veiled in their understanding to this day. They are veiled to the Light, which is Jesus Christ.

The more God's Word abides in you, the more you proclaim His Word, and the more God will work through you, but also in you. Everything is established by His Word. We are not to name it and claim it. Nowhere in the Word does it speak of naming it and claiming it. We are ambassadors of Christ and this is about His Kingdom and His will to be done on earth as it is in heaven and not our own petty kingdoms. Therefore, our faith is not in the word of faith, or in faith, but our faith is in Christ, the Living Word. When we rely on faith, our eyes are on our ability and not on His. We are to look unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith.

When we look to Him, all things are possible. It is absolutely essential that we trust Him with ALL of our heart. That we truly believe that the Word we speak, He will perform. Without faith it is impossible to please Him and we must believe that He is, and is a Rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Building your life upon the Rock is not just saying I believe Jesus died for me and now I am saved. Building your life is about your life...not just a decision you made way back. Your life must be established on the Word of God and this takes years. It is only established by two ways. The first is to trust Him with your whole heart, and the other is to actually do what He says. Faith without works is dead.

This is how we will know what is His good, acceptable or perfect will when we abide in His Word and obey Him. Romans 8 says that those who are led by the Spirit are the sons of God. The Spirit uses the Word of God to direct our paths.

We are told in 2 Corinthians 10: 4 – 10

⁴(For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds)

⁵Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

⁶And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

Note the following words: imaginations, thoughts and high things exalting itself against the knowledge of God. When you are praying for someone, you are pulling down strongholds of the mind. Yes, there are various different strongholds in the spirit as well apart from that which is in the mind.

The enemy also has arrows. (Psalm 91 speaks of the arrows that fly by day). Ephesians 6: 16 states: Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. The Word calls them fiery darts. When these fiery darts lodges into our mind, and is not removed, more fiery darts are sent and it creates a stronghold (this is the dungeons they are held captive in and are tormented by the enemy). Some strongholds are pulled down brick by brick, others by force. So these proclamations are two-fold. For the equipping and setting free of the saints and for the attacking of the enemy.

Please also note that the last verse states that we can take vengeance on disobedience, once our own obedience has been fulfilled. Remember, you make yourself a target when you warfare and so it is very important that the enemy find nothing in you to attack you.

Joshua 1: 8 - 9

⁸ This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

⁹ Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

It takes hard work, diligence and faithfulness. And it takes a resoluteness and understanding that we are to take the Kingdom by force and not give up...ever.

HOW TO PROCLAIM

(With some excerpts taken from Derek Prince's teaching on Proclamations)

Having the right attitude

The first thing to understand is that proclamation is a war cry. When you proclaim you are not suggesting or giving an opinion. You are in the mindset of war. You are there to make war in the heavenlies. It is not for the timid and it takes boldness. There has to be resoluteness and resignation in the authority given and the Word you speak. The understanding and conviction is that...

“When you speak it is just as effective as if God said it, when His Spirit says it through you” – Derek Prince.

Do not expect the enemy to believe you, when you yourself don't believe what you say.

Fear for the Word of God

Derek Prince says that before we can be effective we have to have the fear of the Word of God.

Isaiah 66: 1 – 2 says

66 Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? And where is the place of my rest?

² For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembles at My word.

This is what Jesus says about His Word:

John 12: 47 - 48

⁴⁷ And if any man hear My words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

⁴⁸ He that rejecteth Me, and receiveth not My words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

We have to understand that we are reading and looking at the very thing that will judge us one day. This is a very solemn thought and consideration.

John 14: 23

²³ Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love Me, he will keep My words: and My Father will love him, and We will come unto him, and make Our abode with him.

Take hold of the Word

Psalm 149: 5 – 9

⁵ Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.

⁶ Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and **a two-edged sword in their hand;**

⁷ To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people;

⁸ To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

⁹ To execute upon them the judgment written: this honor have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

Note the words used that is the honor of His saints:

Execute vengeance

Bind the kings with chains and

Bind the nobles with fetters of iron

Execute judgment written (The Word of God)

We have a unique and decisive part to play in this world, far more than we know. We do not make the judgments, but we execute them. We release the judgments of God by proclaiming His Word!

Exercise Authority

We need to take the Word and exercise the authority He has given us where the situation requires it. Proclamation is one of the biggest ways of doing it. By faith, under the anointing of the Spirit, we release the Word in a situation and it has all the authority of God in that situation. It is His Word, not ours. It is His Word that does the work.

Personalize it

Where the Bible says they, or them, and their, you say we, I, mine ours. This simply means that you are saying it applies to now. Essentially your proclamations have to go from your needs to that of aggression where you are attacking.

Be faithful

We have to remember that the enemy has fiery darts that never cease to come our way. He knows our weaknesses and this is his focus. If you struggle with unforgiveness, the arrows he will send to you will be offence, self-pity, anger and vengeance. If you struggle with depression, the arrows he will send is self-pity, hopelessness, fear, suicide, bitterness. If you struggle with fear the arrows will be more anxiety, cowardice, imaginations, unbelief etc. You need to know that in the area you are weak at, he will be strong in. Do not underestimate his schemes. He has been at it for a long time. If your struggle is procrastination, you can know that every possible hindrance and distraction will come your way. Know the fiery darts he sends to you and lift up your shield of faith. The shield of the Roman soldiers (where Paul got his inspiration from for the context of spiritual warfare) had a leather coat over. This leather coat was dipped in water and treated in order to quench the fiery darts the enemy would shoot at them. In the same way, our shield of faith has to be dipped in the water of the Word of God in order to quench the fiery darts of our enemy. Have the scriptures memorized faithfully in order to counter these attacks by faith.

You have to be faithful in your fight against the enemy. Shooting now and then or just when you feel that things are getting a bit “hot” is not enough. You are always in a war. Always be vigilant and stay aware at all times. You cannot expect to win a war if you are not faithful. You have to every day push back the enemy. Remember that the stronghold is in your mind or in the person you are praying for, and it is through the habitual putting to death the works of the flesh that we overcome. Be faithful and He will show Himself faithful to you. Do not give up no matter how difficult the war. He has already overcome the world. Be guided by the Spirit of God. This is the Sword of the Spirit. The Sword of the Spirit is the Rhema word of God.

GENERAL COVERING PROCLAMATION

(Milton Green)

He lifted me out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay. He put my feet upon a rock, and made my footsteps firm. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to my God. Many has seen and trusted in the Lord and blessed is the man who trust in the Lord and has not turned to the proud, nor lapsed into falsehood. Many, oh Lord, are the wonders that thou hast done. Thou thoughts are towards me. There is none that compare to Thee. My ears have opened up, and I said, "Behold Lord, I come to Thee, in the scroll of the book it is written of me."

I delight to do Thy will. Thine law is written in my heart. Because I have been born again and to a living hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ. I am dead. I have an inheritance that is incorruptible, undefiled and fades not away, reserved in heaven for me. MORNING PROCLAMATION

The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall not want. I have tasted and seen that the Lord is good, because I trust in Him. I fear the Lord and therefore I will have no want. He is my provision and my source of joy, health, peace and deliverance. My soul shall be joyful in the Lord: It shall rejoice in His salvation!

He makes me to lie down in green pastures and He leads me beside still waters. My mind is fixed on Him and I trust in Him, therefore He will keep me in perfect peace. I will be still and know that He is God. He leads me in paths of righteousness for His Name sake. All the paths of wisdom is peace. Therefore, even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil. He will never leave nor forsake me. For every temptation He will make a way to escape. His rod and staff will protect and comfort me in this day. I proclaim that this is the day that the Lord has made and I will rejoice and be glad in it. No weapon formed against me shall prosper, but every tongue that rises against me in judgment, I will condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord and my righteousness is of Him.

He has prepared a table for me in the presence of my enemies. I will feast from the bread and wine that wisdom has decked on this table. For the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom. I receive wisdom by faith in the Name of Jesus for every situation or challenge in this day. I will not lean on my own understanding, but I will acknowledge Him in all my ways. He will make my way straight. I will not look to the left or right, but look straight on and He will establish my way.

He anoints my head with oil and this anointing I receive so that every yoke, every burden will fall off me. I will only take His yoke upon me in this day. I receive this anointing that will teach me in everything I do. He has removed the spirit of heaviness from me and has clothed me with a garment of praise!
