

I Corinthians 15:1-4

1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the **Gospel** which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.

3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that **Christ died** for our sin according to the scriptures;

4 And that **He was buried**, and that **He rose again** the third day according to the scriptures:

GOSPEL

DEATH	BURIAL	RESURRECTION

Repent	Be Baptized	Receive the Gift

Acts 2:38

38 Then Peter said unto them, **Repent**, and **be baptized** every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall **receive the gift** of the Holy Ghost.

1st BAPTISM(clear and lowkey verses) of ACTS 2:38

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, REPENT, and be bAPTIZED every one of you in the name of JESUS CHRIST for the REMISSION of SINS, and ye shall RECEIVE the gift of the HOLY GHOST.

(note 1: so we have to find verses speaking/meantioning the name of Jesus Christ,baptising for the remission of sins(DEATH/BURIAL) and receiving the gift of Holy Ghost(RESSURECTION)

(note 2:there is DEATH(metaphorically and literally during seals) in 1st baptism and its different to be baptised and receive the Holy Ghost from being baptised from the Holy Ghost right??right)

1)LUKE 3:3 And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins (REMISSION OF SINS)

2)LUKE 7:28 For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than

he.(thats why John is the least,he had only the VERBAL FAITH not water baptism)

3)LUKE 3:21 Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened(this baptism of Jesus opens HEAVEN)

4)MARK 1:4 John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.(REMISSION OF SINS)

5)ROMANS 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.(BURIAL)

6)ROMANS 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?(DEATH)

7)GALATIANS 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.(baptised into Christ)

8)COLOSSIANS 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.(BURIAL)

9)1 PETERS 3:21 The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ.(RESSURECTION)

10)1 COR 15:29 Else what shall they do which are baptized for the dead, if the dead rise not at all? why are they then baptized for the dead?(DEATH/RESSURECTION)

11)ACTS 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.(no comment here!!)

12)ACTS 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.(BAPTISM TO JESUS CHRIST->KINGDOM of GOD)

13)ACTS 8:16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)(BAPTISM in the name LORD JESUS)

14)ACTS 10:47 Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we?(WATER baptism->RECEIVE HOLY SPIRIT)

15)ACTS 10:48 And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days.(BAPTISM IN LORD's NAME)

16)ACTS 19:4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ

Jesus.(BELIEVE/BAPTISM IN CHRIST JESUS)

17)ACTS 19:5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.(BAPTISM IN LORD JESUS)

18)ACTS 22:16 And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.(BAPTISM IN LORD and WASH AWAY SINS=REMISSION of SINS)

2nd BAPTISM(clear and lowkey verses) of MATTHEW 28:19

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

(note 1:have to find verses being baptised BY the HOLY GHOST/SPIRIT of GOD and FIRE)

(note 2:there is NO DEATH-at least metaphorically during trumpets-)

1)MATTHEW 3:16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:(SPIRIT of GOD)(maybe this is wrong choice)

2)MATTHEW 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

3)MATTHEW 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:(BAPTISM with HOLY GHOST and FIRE)

4)MARK 1:8 I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.(BAPTISM with HOLY GHOST)

5)LUKE 3:16 John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:(SHALL BAPTIZED(future) with HOLY GHOST and FIRE)

6)JOHN 1:33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.(BAPTISM with HOLY GHOST)

7)JOHN 4:2 (Though Jesus himself baptized not, but his disciples,)(maybe thats a wrong verse too but u get what i try to show...maybe belongs to the 1st baptism)

8)ACTS 1:5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.(SHALL BAPTISE with HOLY GHOST)

9)ACTS 11:16 Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.(BAPTISM with HOLY GHOST)

10)1 COR 12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.(now that i look that verse again,maybe it goes to the 1st baptism maybe not)

SPECIAL NOTES(why we need baptism and not just verbal faith)

1)LUKE 7:30 But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.(NO BAPTISM->REJECTION of GOD)

2)MARK 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.(BELIEVE+BAPTISM=SAVED....NO BELIEVE(no baptism)=DAMNED...(no martini no party haha:)))

3)ACTS 10:47 Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we?(WATER BAPTISM=RECEIVE HOLY GHOST)(that goes to the 1st Baptism too i think)

4)many people in ACTS had only JOHN's baptism(REPENTANCE-VERBAL FAITH and NO WATER BAPTISM)
